**NOTIFICATION**

Dacca, the 9th May, 1975

**No. S.R.O. 166-L/75**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 60 of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Dacca, is pleased to exempt the expatriate specialist of the Federal Republic of Germany, employed in Bangladesh Telephone Factory and the Department of Telephone, and Telegraph by the Ministry of Ports, Telegraphs and Telephones, Dacca, under the Agreement between the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Dacca, under the agreement between the Government of the Peoples Republic of Bangladesh and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, concerning technical and economic Co-operation from payment of Income-tax under the said Act in respect of emoluments received or deemed to be received by or accruing or arising deemed to accrue or arise in Bangladesh to any of the expatriate

"specialists" for services within the framework, of the said agreement from funds of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany.
