**NOTIFICATION**  
Dacca, the 4th August, 1978

**No. S.R.O. 220-L/78.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 60 of the Income-tax Act, 1922, the Government is pleased to exempt the expatriate personnel employed in Bangladesh by the Orthopaedic and Rehabilitation Unit of Shaheed Suhrawardy Hospital Complex, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, Dacca, from payment of tax under the said Act in respect of—

- (a) Maintenance allowance received in Bangladesh by any of expatriate personnel of the said Unit provided the services rendered by such personnel are purely voluntary without any salary or other remuneration;
- (b) Salary or other remuneration received or deemed to be received by or accruing or arising or deemed to accrue or arise in Bangladesh to any of the expatriate personnel of the said Unit provided the salary or other remuneration of such personnel is also exempt from payment of tax in the country of domicile of the expatriate personnel and evidence in respect of the same is produced to the Bangladesh Income-tax authority.
